Project Background:Elevation Surveying submitted a lot line revision to staff. It was determined upon review that if the lot line was to proceed, we would need a rezone, to eliminate split zoned parcel that would be created. Approximately 1.844 acres are being conveyed to Parcel 027-1-21C which with then be absorbed into 027-1-31. The 1.844 acres is currently zoned Low Density Residential and will need to be rezoned to Agriculture to allow this revision.

Support of the Comprehensive Plan:

Policy 1.1.3Evaluate Zoning Districts to ensure the current uses align with the Zoning Map where deemed necessary when compatible with the surroundingareas.

Objective 1.3:Support Agriculture and Forestry in Pulaski County.

VDOT Review: VDOT provided a preliminary review and takes no exceptionto the rezone.

<u>Health, Safety, Welfare:</u> The area is agriculture in nature and there does not appear to be any health, safety or welfare concerns.

<u>Virginia Department of Health</u>: The property is served by public water through the PSA. The Virginia Department of Health takes no exceptionto the rezone.
