### Project Background:

Cicely Solar is a proposed solar photovolta Project with a maximum size of 5 megawatts alternating current and is owned by Cicely Solar, LLC . The Project is proposed to be located on parcels 047-050-0000-0011, 047-050-0000-008, and 046-014-0000-0011. The Applicant has entered into a Lease Agreement with Frederick and Stephanie Hyduke to enable construction and operations of the Project. The Projects proposed area of development will occupy approximately 31.00 acres off of Black Hollow Heights Lane, just west of Route 100 and north of U.S. Route 11

The Project will provide clean, local, domestic energy which will be distributed on the existing electric lines to serve Pulaski County and surrounding communities. The Project will connect directly to Appalachian Power Companys distribution system. It is estimated the Project will produce enough energy to meet the energy needs of approximately 1,200 average Virginia households annually.

The Project will undergo the Permit-By-Rule process required for Projects de minimis or 5 MW and under. This process will include coordinated reviews by the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality and the provide the required Notice of Intent to localities upon receipt of discretionary permits.

**Virginia Department of Transportation:**

A VDOT comment letter in response to the traffic and access plan is pending. The developer will be required to obtain a Land Use Permit from VDOT for any temporary and permanent entrances as part of the project. Staff suggests that any entrance concerns are addressed by the local VDOT Land Use Division and any concerns can be mitigated as part of the VDOT permit process. After the solar project is constructed, traffic into the project area will be for periodic maintenance and considered minimal. The proposed land use will not create long term transportation or traffic impacts to the community.

**Virginia Department of Health:**The property is served by Public Sewer and Public Water; the Virginia Department of Health take no exception.

**Health, Safety, Welfare:**The area is Residential and Agriculture in nature and there does not appear to be any health, safety or welfare concerns.
